## **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

### **1) EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE**

The event shall be known as the Collie Motorplex Ernie Hastie Memorial Race & Regularity Meeting to be held on Saturday 18th & Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2019 at Collie Motorplex, Lot 643 Powerhouse Road, Collie Western Australia.

### **2) ORGANISATION AND STATUS**

- (a) The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, CAMS Race Meeting Standing Regulations, CAMS Regularity Trial – Standing Regulations, 2019 CAMS WA Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations, 2019 CAMS WA Historic Race Regularity Hillclimb and Sprint Regulations, National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any amendments, further regulations, bulletins and instructions to competitors that may be issued.
- (b) This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)
- (c) Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Program Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au).
- (d) The Event shall be a State Race and Regularity Event.

- (iii) **Entry Fee: For all Racing Classes except HQ Holdens:** \$200.00 (GST inc) + \$25.00 per Dorian  
**Entry Fee: For HQ Holdens:** \$300.00 (GST inc)+ \$25.00 per Dorian  
**Entry Fee: For Regularity:** \$150.00 (GST inc) + \$25.00 per Dorian

- (v) **Refunds:** No monies will be refunded after Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2019
- (vi) **Restricted Entries:** The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason, in accordance with NCR 83
- (vii) **Number of Entries:** The maximum number of entries is 200 accepted in order of receipt.
- (viii) **Event cancellation:** Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual. Should the event be cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, MSW reserves the right to withhold a percentage of the refund to cover costs.

- (ix) **Vehicle Eligibility:** The Regularity will be conducted for vehicles of CAMS Groups **A, C, F, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V**, as outlined in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, together with invited cars of compatible type.

The Racing will be conducted for CAMS Log-booked cars from Improved Production Cars, Hyundai Excel, Street Cars, Invited Sports Cars, Invited Sports Sedans, Saloon Cars, HQ Holdens, Historic Touring Cars, Formula Ford, Formula Vee and Formula Classic (Formula Libre) classes.

\*\*\*Please note if a category does not reach a minimum of 12 entries they may be amalgamated with another category (where suitable)\*\*\*

## 6) MEMBERSHIP

All nominated drivers must be a member of a CAMS-affiliated Club. The consent of a parent or guardian must appear on the entry form for any driver under 18 years of age.

## 7) LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

All Race Drivers must hold at a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit Licence. Provisional licences will be held and can be collected from the Race Control at the conclusion of the Meeting.

All Drivers holding Provisional licences must have displayed a 'P' plate on the rear of their vehicle in accordance with Schedule K. Those who do not may be penalised by the Stewards.

Drivers in the Regularity and Super Sprint must hold a minimum of a CAMS Speed (previously known as L2S) Licence.

## 8) EVENTS

The Event program will be issued closer to the event, however there will be 1 practice session, 1 qualifying session and 3 competitive events for racing classes except for Formula Fords and Formula Classics (Formula Libre).

Formula Ford and Formula Classic (Formula Libre) will have 1 practice session, 1 qualifying session and 4 competitive events.

Regularity classes will have 2 practice sessions and 3 regularity trials.

## 9) SCRUTINY and DOCUMENT CHECK

All Entrants must present their vehicle and logbook (if issued) for Scrutiny, all vehicles must be adequately muffled, and all vehicles entered in Regularity must be equipped with a suitable fire extinguisher.

Any vehicle entered for Regularity Events (only) that has a CAMS logbook and complies with current Targeted Scrutiny Regulations will be required to present for an abbreviated Scrutiny of Driver apparel, paper work, and a brief safety check (including fire extinguisher) at the Scrutineering Bay.

Any vehicle not complying with the Audit requirements under Targeted Scrutiny Regulations must be presented for scrutiny at a time and place specified in the Supplementary Regulations for that Event.

Scrutineering will occur Saturday 18th May and Sunday 19th May from 7:05am – 8:05am in the Scrutineering Bay of the Collie Motorplex circuit.

At Scrutiny your helmet must be presented for inspection and approval. Your CAMS Licence, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and logbook (if applicable) must be produced at Scrutiny and on request during the Meeting.

## 10) DRIVERS' BRIEFING and SIGN ON

All Drivers competing at this Event must attend a **compulsory Drivers' Briefing and Sign-on where they will receive their wrist bands** on Saturday at 8:20am for all Drivers and Sunday 8:20am for any Drivers who did not compete on Saturday in the Clubroom.

**Failure to attend the Briefing may result in exclusion from participation at the Meeting.**

## 11) PRACTICE/START TIMES:

Entrants will, as directed by the Clerk of the Course or an Official to take part in Qualifying or Practice which are scheduled to start from 8:45am. Refer Ernie Hastie program for approximate times.

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all cars to be fitted with a Dorian Data-1 transmitter, which is the Competitor's responsibility for all practice, qualifying and races.

(a) **Qualifying is required by all Race Drivers, and Practice for all Regularity Drivers. In the case of Regularity Drivers, should you find that for exceptional reasons that you are unable to practice you must see the Clerk of the Course and present your case. You are not permitted to re-nominate a time unless you have had approval to do so by the Clerk of the Course**

(b) The Competition events are scheduled to start at 11:05am on Saturday and at 10:10am on Sunday.

## 12) STARTING POSITIONS

(a) **Race Events:** All starts will be standing starts.

(b) **Regularity/Time Challenge Events:** As outlined in Regularity Trial – Standing Regulations Clause 9  
STARTING PROCEDURE

(c) **Nominating times (Regularity/Time Challenge drivers):**

After Practice 2 you are to nominate your lap time in the Collie Motorplex Clubroom. These times will be relayed to the Chief Timekeeper.

## 13) REFUELING

Drivers should note that there is no fuel for sale at the venue. There will be no refuelling allowed unless the ignition is switched off, there is an assistant standing by with a fire extinguisher and the driver is outside the vehicle. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

## 14) RESULTS & PROTESTS

Provisional Times and Results will be displayed on the notice board near the 'Sign-On' area in the Collie Motorplex Clubroom as soon as possible after each Event. Copies of provisional results will be available on the day or Natsoft. Confirmed results may be published in the participating Club's newsletters and web-sites. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

## 15) AWARDS

Trophies will be presented at a time and place to be further advised. See Ernie Hastie Memorial schedule for further information.

## 16) NON-COMPETITION VEHICLES:

- (i) Vehicles used for camping must be located in the designated Camping Area Only
- (ii) Any non-competition car must be parked in the carpark near the entry of the track or in the camping area.
- (iii) Loading or unloading of trailers in the pit/paddock area from the beginning to the end of the day's competition until the end of the final competition event of the day is prohibited unless specifically directed by the Clerk of the Course.

## 17) TRAILER PARKING

All trailers **must** be parked in the designated 'trailer parking' area and not in the pit area – non-compliance of this rule will cause the event to be delayed. Please note this area will be locked whilst the event is running. Please see Event Secretary to have area unlocked once Clerk of the Course provides permission for this to occur.

## 18) PIT BAY ALLOCATIONS

Pit Bays will be allocated to all drivers and can be found in the Collie Motorplex Clubrooms on both pinup boards. Pit bays A1-A11, B1-B9 and C1-C22 are undercover, bays A12, B10-B18, D1-D7, E1-E6, F1-F17 and G1-G33 are in the open therefore it is in your best interest to bring a marquee/shelter. Any queries to be directed to the Event Secretary.

## 19) ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

## 20) PARADE

Parade may be held during the lunch break for invited cars only. This will be in accordance with NCR 20a. The cars will run in a group behind the Safety Car. A second car will follow the field. The Parade will be conducted at a speed of no more than 60km/hr. Only nominated drivers for the car will be able to drive in the Parade. There will be no timing of the Parade and overtaking is strictly forbidden. Cars must remain in their starting formation at all times and drivers must remain within two car lengths of the car in front and not allow a space to open up between cars.

MSPRA (Motorsport Passenger Ride Activity) will be included in the Parade and ALL passengers MUST sign a "Passenger Ride Entry Form". In the case of those passengers under the age of 18, the parent or guardian must have signed the disclaimer allowing participation, prior to the participant entering the vehicle.

**Passengers under the age of 12 are not permitted.**

In accordance with the MSPRA Policy, only cars that have entered the event will be able to participate in the parade. There will be a drivers briefing and passengers briefing held at 11:00am in the Collie Motorplex Clubroom. Non-attendance at this briefing will mean non-participation in the parade.

**All persons must be adequately restrained and conform to NCR 20A.**

## 21) CATERING

The Collie Motorplex canteen will be available both Saturday and Sunday from approximately 7.00am to approximately 3.00pm. **\*\*\*please note it is cash only\*\*\***

## 22) CAMPING/ACCOMMODATION.

Collie has a range of Motels to choose from and also camping is encouraged at the circuit on the Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights **but your intention to stay over must be advised prior to the Friday.** Limited bunk room accommodation is available – this **must** to be 'booked'.

**Camping Fees are compulsory to assist with water, gas, electricity and cleaning costs:**

Camp Site: \$10.00 per person per night

Bunkhouse: \$15.00 per person per night

***Camping in the designated camping area is UNPOWERED and use of extension leads is NOT permitted – generators are ok.***
